



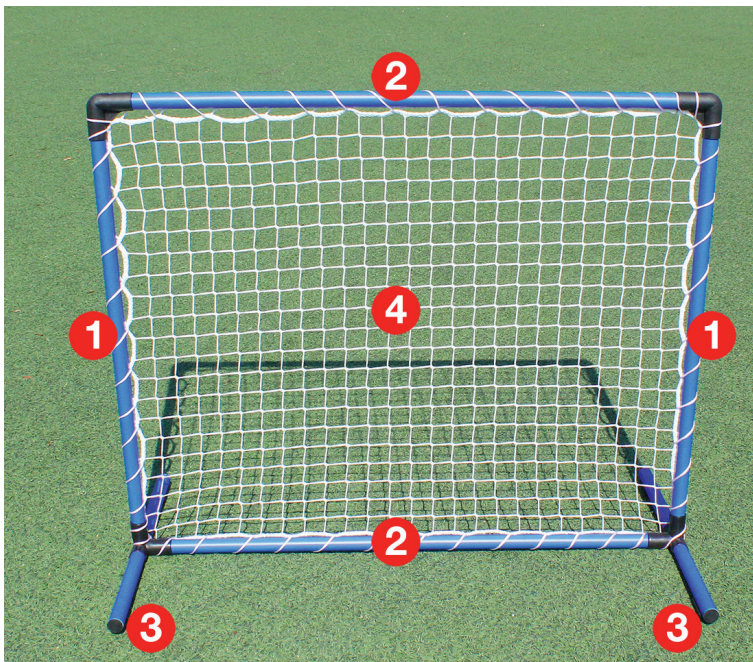
Hoopers Gate Assembly Instructions

The Hoopers gate (or Hoopers fence) is a barrier used in Hoopers sports. The fence is used to guide the dog on the track or to delimit certain areas.

Hoopers fences are typically made from lightweight materials such as plastic or PVC to make them easy to transport and set up. The fences are low enough that

they do not hinder the dog, but high enough to serve as a visible guardrail.

The fence can be used to guide the dog's direction of movement or to help him stay on the intended course. It is often used in combination with other Hoopers equipment such as tunnels, barrels and arches.



The package contains two side parts (1) with a 90° angle, two crossbars at the top and bottom (2), two feet with square connectors and four extension bars (3) and a white net (4).

Tip: Assembly is easier with two people

1. Connect the ground rod (2) to the two feet/square connectors (3) on the left and right.
2. Then insert the two side bars (1) into the square connectors on the left and right.
3. Then add the side bars/90° angles (1), the upper crossbar (2).



4. Finally, connect the net (4) with the enclosed attach the cord to the frame. All you need to do is thread the cord through each one. Thread the second opening of the net and wrap it around wrap the rod. Finally, knot the cord on the frame.
